3-day Workshop: Wet & Workable Watercolor; Portraits & Pets

Take the intimidation out of painting portraits once you discover they are comprised of shapes, colors & values like any subject. Discover strategies for building those shapes and values. Develop an understanding of how lighting can help simplify paintable shapes. Learn to approach portraits with an understanding of facial proportions, features and appropriate lighting. Demonstrations of how to create different flesh tones. Then let loose with confidence to enhance color, character and personal expression after practicing the basics. Bring basic water-color materials with quality watercolor paper, tracing paper. Tabletop easel to support your paper at an angle is also suggested. Materials list upon request.
